Be Bear Wise



Area bears have awakened from their long winters' nap.

Please remember to practice good 'Bear Wise' habits for us and the bears.

The Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry has lots of good information on their website regarding bears. Visit www.ontario.ca/page/prevent-bearencounters-bear-wise for a variety of information such as how to remove bear attractants, who to contact for emergencies or non-emergencies, etc. When bears pick up a scent with their keen noses, they will investigate it. If they find bird food, garbage or pet food they will return as long as the food source is available. Here are a few reminders: put garbage out only on the morning of garbage day, not the night before; put garbage in containers that have tightfitting lids and store it in a bear-proof location such as your basement or a sturdy garage; spray garbage cans and lids with bleach or another strong disinfectant; do not leave pet food outdoors, in screened- in areas or porches.

The Business Side of Things

Statutory Holiday Hours: The Municipal Office will be closed Monday, July 1st and Monday, August 5th.

Final tax bills will be sent out near the end of August. The first

installment of this bill will be due by September 30, 2019 and the second installment will be due by November 29, 2019.
