

Waste & Recycling Information

Seasonal Compost

Collection is scheduled to take place on May 1st, 8th, (weather, unplanned water **15th, 23rd** and **29th**. This service is for the collection of lawn rakings, leaves and may also want to consider small bundles of brush and twigs. Bagged compost must be in paper bags. Plastic bags will NOT be accepted. Brush must cut into 4' lengths and tied into manageable bundles. This service is provided by municipal staff and may be delayed due to

circumstances beyond control of the village i.e. distribution maintenance, emergencies, etc.) You composting your lawn rakings for future use.

The next Large Item Pick**up** is Monday, April 24th. You must register for this service no later than 4 p.m. on Wednesday, April 19th, by calling the South River Municipal Office (705)386-2573.

North Bay's Household **Hazardous Waste**

Be Bear Wise!



Please remember to practice good 'Bear Wise' habits for us and the bears.

The Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry has lots of good information on their website regarding bears, be sure to www.ontario.ca/page/ prevent-bear-encounters-bearwise. When bears pick up a scent with their keen noses, they will investigate it. If they find bird food, garbage or pet food they will return as long as the food source is available.

Here are a few reminders: put garbage out only on the morning of garbage day, not the night before; put garbage in containers that have tight-fitting lids and store it in a bear-proof location such as your basement or a sturdy garage; spray garbage cans and lids with bleach or another strong disinfectant; do not leave pet food outdoors, in screened- in areas or porches.

Have you got a comment or a complaint, about something in the community,? A comment/complaint form is required in writing before any action can be done. Our By-Law officer CANNOT follow up on any complaints unless it is in writing signed and delivered to the office. Forms are available at the office or online at southriver.ca If it's not in writing ... it didn't happen!

By-Law Brief

Residents are reminded that Bylaw 49-2022 (Regulating Poultry and Livestock) came into effect on January 1, 2023. This bylaw prohibits the keeping of any poultry and livestock within the Village other than hens. A license to keep hens is now a requirement.

Application forms are available on their dog with the Village, and shall pay a licence fee once for a lifetime licence for the life of the dog. The Municipal Law Enforcement Officer can be contacted with questions, complaints, or inquiries at almaguinbylaw@southriver.ca.

Don't Forget To Pay Your Taxes & Water!

The due date for the first installment of the 2023 Interim Tax Bill is Friday, March 31st and the second installment is due on Friday June 30th. Please keep a copy of all tax receipts, there is a fee of \$30.00 for duplicate copies

of receipts, bills, etc. If you are preparing your income tax return and need your 2022 property tax values, please refer to your 2022 Final Tax Bill. You can also find your 2022 Tax Levy at the top of your 2023 Interim Tax Bill. If your

taxes are in arrears, procrastinate. Please contact the office municipal to payment arrangements to avoid additional interest being added to your account.
