#### **Water Issues**

From time to time you may experience coloured water coming out of your taps.

If you experience any coloured water, or any issues with your water please let us know, as it maybe caused from an issue we are unaware of. Coloured water can happen if there is a broken pipe somewhere in the distribution lines, or if a fire hydrant was accessed. You may experience low water pressure or coloured water if there is also an issue with your water lines.

Just remember that the water lines from the curb stop into your house is your responsibility, not the Villages. If you have a water emergency call the Village office during regular business hours: 705-386-2573 after hours call the emergency Public works number of 705-386-0245.

#### Waste and Recycling

Garbage is to be at the curb no later than 8 am every Friday. It is not always the same driver, a different driver can mean a different route and pick up times will vary. Garbage is to be out 8 am to 8pm.

Recycling saves us all money, it also cuts back on the amount of garbage a household produces, as we have a 2 bag limit weekly, regular household garbage bags are to be used, Construction bags will not be taken. If you are using the small white kitchen catcher bags, each bag will count as 1 unless they are put into a large bag.

Recycling saves our landfills from filling up too fast. Recycling bins can be purchased at the local hardware store, it doesn't have to be green/blue. Just be sure to put out the proper stuff on the appropriate week, a recycling calendar is available at the office or on our website southriver.ca. If you do not have a garbage can to put your garbage in but are concerned about the birds or animals getting into it and ripping the bags put a blanket over it. If birds/animals do rip your garbage apart, Please clean it up so it doesn't blow into your neighbours yard or into the ditches for others to clean up, lets work together to keep our Village clean and tidy. Large Item pick up is on Monday August 12th. This is a service you must call in to register your items or they will NOT be picked up, if you register and then find more things you must call to add it, if it is not on the list the driver will not take it. Last day to register for LARGE ITEM PICK UP is Wednesday August 7th @ 4 PM. Next large item pick up will be November 4th, 2024.

#### **By-Law Brief**

As the summer season begins, the Bylaw Enforcement Department would like to remind residents that the keeping of backyard hens is regulated by Bylaw 49-2022. Owners of hens must apply for a licence and complete a site inspection prior to purchasing or keeping hens on their property. The maximum number of hens permitted is 6.

Copies of the licence application Or are available at the Village office or on our website. Residents are encouraged to reach out to the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer with questions or inquiries around the hen licencing bylaw.

#### **Code Red**

If you haven't already done so, take a moment to sign up for *Code Red*. Code Red can inform you about local emergency situations, water related priorities such as boil water advisories or water conservation requirements, etc.

When a Code Red message is sent, those who have signed up for the service receive the message instantly. In order to receive these messages, you must sign-up for the service. Call the South River—Machar Fire Department @ (705)386-0066 for more information or to sign-up. You can also sign-up online at www.srmfd.com. When you receive a Code Red message, it will come from a 1-855 phone number, don't mistake it for a telemarketer. Please visit the Village of South River's website at southriver.ca for a checklist of items that should be in your 72 hour emergency kits and more information on emergency preparation and planning.

#### Have you been unable to pay Your Taxes & Water....

If you have fallen behind on your tax or water account and are not sure how you can get caught up, please call us. We will work with you on a payment plan to get you back on track. Interest is run for taxes on the first of every month, water interest is run on

the 16th of the month or the next business day. If property taxes reach 2nd year arrears it will be sent for tax sale. The process is very expensive and gets added to your tax account. Disconnection water notices will be mailed once your account is over \$250. A deposit could be added for delinquent accounts at a residential rate of \$300 and a non-residential rate of \$350. If we need to disconnect your water, a deposit will be required to turn it on, plus disconnection and reconnection fees will be charged.
