Waste & Recycling Information

Seasonal Compost **Collection** is scheduled to take place on May 6th, 13th, 21st and 27th. This service is for the collection of lawn rakings, leaves and may also want to consider small bundles of brush and twigs. Bagged compost must be in paper bags. Plastic bags will NOT be accepted. Brush must cut into 4' lengths and tied into manageable bundles. This service is provided by municipal staff and may be delayed due to

circumstances beyond control of the village i.e. (weather, unplanned water distribution maintenance, emergencies, etc.) You composting your lawn rakings for future use.

The next Large Item Pickup is Monday, April 22nd You must register for this service no later than 4 p.m. on Wednesday, April 17th, by calling the South River Municipal Office (705)386-2573.

North Bay's Household Hazardous Waste & **Electronics Program** accepts various hazardous waste products and electronics on a year round basis for Village of South River residents at 112 Patton St. North Bay, Wednesday to Saturday 8 AM to 6 PM. The Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry has lots of good information on their website regarding bears, be sure to visit www.ontario.ca/page/ prevent-bear-encounters-bearwise. When bears pick up a scent with their keen noses, they will investigate it. If they find bird food, garbage or pet food they will return as long as the food source is available.

Here are a few reminders: put garbage out only on the morning of garbage day, not the night before; put garbage in containers that have tight-fitting lids and store it in a bear-proof location such as your basement or a sturdy garage; spray garbage cans and lids with bleach or another strong disinfectant; do not leave pet food outdoors, in screened- in areas or porches.

Have you got a comment or a complaint, about something in the community,? A comment/complaint form is required in writing before any action can be done. Our By-Law officer CANNOT follow up on any complaints unless it is in writing signed and delivered to the office.
